# HERDADE DA COMPORTA

## RED 2007

Region	Comporta
Total Vineyard Area	30ha (25ha of red grapes and 5ha of white grapes)
Category	Vinho Regional Península de Setúbal
Style	Red wine
Grape Varieties	Aragonez, Trincadeira, Alicante Bouschet and Touriga Franca
Tasting Note	Bright garnet in colour. On the nose a combination of very ripe fruit with oaky character. Elegant, with, concentrated fruit, well-structured tannins and a long, complex finish.
Soil Type	Sandy
Exposure and Slope	The vineyard is planted on flat land in a valley that runs from east to west, and is thus exposed to the sun practically all day long.
Position	Slightly above sea level.
Climate	Mild, thanks to its proximity to the ocean, with gentle winds, ideal for producing grapes with good colour, aroma and flavour.
Vinification	The grapes, all from our vineyard, were picked by hand into 20kg plastic boxes, the grape varieties kept separate. The wine was fermented exclusively in small open tanks at controlled temperature. Handled minimally, it was aged in Allier oak barrels and then for a further time in bottle.
