Wine Description

Porrais vineyards are located in an area of the Demarcated Region of the Douro (Murça) traditionally known for the high quality wines. The wine is a blend of the native varieties Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Sousão, Tinta Barroca from vines planted in shale soils at an altitude of 600 meters.

Tasting Notes

This wine presents notes of red fruits and spices. On the mouth is smooth with soft and balanced tannins, revealing notes of ripe red fruits and spices. Pairs very well with pasta, cheese and meat dishes.

Vinification

The grapes were harvested in September into 20 kg boxes and transported to the cellar where they were chosen manually and were subsequently stripped and crushed. Fermentation and the malolactic fermentation occurred in stainless steel tank with temperature control. The wine aged in French oak casks for a 6 months period.
